

Things to see and places to go between Orbost Visitor Information Centre and Lakes Entrance Visitor Information Centre via the Princes Hwy (V3 – Nov 2016)

Wooden Railway viaduct	1.3 Km from Orbost VIC to the turnoff	Viaduct is visible from the Princes Hwy or turn left at the Snowy River Country trail sign and go under the highway for a closer look	<p>Wooden trestle viaduct which was part of the railway line across the Snowy River floodplain. Longest timber rail bridge in Victoria</p> 
Grandview lookout	4.1 Km from Orbost VIC to the turnoff	Turn sharp right off Princes Hwy at the start of the Newmerella township. Travel 1.0 Km to lookout, last 50 metres is gravel road	<p>Lookout over Snowy River flats, picnic area, no toilets</p> 
Corringle beach and The Slips –	4.2 Km from Orbost VIC to the turnoff	Turn left at the start of Newmerella township and follow Corringle Rd 14.4 km to its end at the camping area and access to the beach and Snowy Rv estuary. (Note the first 4.4 km is bitumen and then another 10 km of gravel.) Park and walk to Lonely Bay (about 1 hour) Alternatively stay on Blackfellows Arm Tk and drive a further 1.4 Km to the Lonely Bay picnic area carpark and picnic area. Mill Point		Turn left at Lake Tyers Beach Rd and travel 1 Km to Toorloo Arm junction. Turn left on Mill point Rd and travel another 3.8 Km to Mill Point (last 0.5 Km is gravel)	Jet ski area, canoe launching, picnic area, fishing, boat ramp
Lake Bunga Beach	54.1Km from Orbost VIC	Turn left and travel 1.4 km on bitumen road then 0.5 Km on gravel road to car park. Short walk to estuary and beach	Fishing (estuary and ocean), ocean access, canoeing, toilets
Eastern Beach	56.3Km from Orbost VIC	Turn left and travel 0.7 Km to carpark. Short walk to beach	Ocean access, swimming, fishing, picnic area, toilets
Main Beach	57.9Km from Orbost VIC	Park at footbridge (traffic lights) and walk to main beach	Swimming, fishing, picnic areas, toilets, all water activities
Lakes Entrance VIC	59.9Km from Orbost VIC	Turn right at roundabout – 100 metres to VIC	Toilets, car park
